Scholarship Requirements

You must meet the following requirements in order to be eligible for a Southern Bowling Congress Scholarship.

1. You must be a high school senior. Unless you are 18 years old by August 1st of your Senior year, you must be currently bowling in a USBC Certified Youth League.
2. You must have bowled in a USBC Certified Youth League for two out of your four years in high school and must have bowled 75% of the league schedule in your final year of bowling in that Youth League.
3. You must include an official high school grade and credits transcript with a minimum of 6 semesters of information that includes proof of your ACT and/or SAT scores.
4. **You must attach a personal letter of recommendation from either your high school principal or your counselor.**
5. You must have attained an ACT composite score of at least 20 or a SAT composite score of 1020-1050 on the 1600 scale or 1390-1430 on the 2400 scale. Send a copy of test scores from testing agency.
6. You **must** have attained a composite grade point average of at least 2.50 on a 4.0 scale.
7. After you have been notified that you are a recipient of a SBC Scholarship, you must continue to bowl in your USBC Certified Youth League until the completion of the schedule or your scholarship may be rescinded.
8. The application must be completed and returned to the Executive Director of the Southern Bowling Congress by March 15th of the year you are applying for you to be considered in the SBC Scholarship program.
9. The decision of the Southern Bowling Congress is final regarding all scholarship matters, including, but not limited to the interpretation of the information received, and the recipient selection process.
